

CITB SSSTS Refresher

Course Introduction

The SSSTS course is specifically designed for individuals who have or are about to have on-site supervisory responsibilities. The qualification will enable qualified supervisors to renew their certificates over 1, rather than 2 days. It will revive and rejuvenate current SSSTS holder's understandings of health, safety, welfare and environmental issues, as well as the legal responsibilities they have, relevant to their work activities.

Course Pre-Requisites

Students must hold a valid and current CITB Skills SSSTS certificate
