

ROLO Health, Safety and Environmental Awareness

Course Introduction

ROLO or Register of Landbased Operatives is a one-day Health Safety and Environmental Awareness course designed for people who work in the forestry industry, agriculture, landscape management and highway maintenance. Achievement of ROLO is mandatory for individuals wishing to obtain a LISS/CSCS card that would allow them to work in a highway environment.

The course is also intended to give delegates the knowledge that will allow them to achieve the LISS/CSCS card.
